Rutherford County Senior Center in Spindale is closed to the public, but we are still providing hot meals for seniors.

- Rutherford County Senior Center Satellite Sites (Ellenboro, Henrietta, and Shingle Hollow) are closed.
- Meals may be picked up at the main site on Callahan Koon Rd for participants 60 years of age and older. To receive a meal, you must call by 12 noon the day before.
- Rutherford County Senior's age 60 and over who are interested in receiving a meal but are not a participant, please call 287-6409 for more information.
- We will continue to deliver meals to the home-bound (Home Delivered Meals/MOW) on regular schedule.
- Senior Center staff will be present to answer phones during business hours.
