The Lake Advisory Board held a Regular Meeting at the Lake Lure Municipal Center on Monday, the 5th day of November, 2018 at 3:30 p.m.

Call to Order and Agenda Review:

Chairman Mark Helms called the meeting to order at 3:38 p.m. The Board unanimously agreed to approve the Agenda as presented.

Approval of the Minutes:

Mr. Dan Breneman made a motion to approve the October 5th, 2018 Regular Meeting Minutes as presented. Mr. Bill Ashman seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Individual Meeting Reports and Actions:

Lake Operations Department – The Lake Operations Department's Report was sent out by Lake Operations Director Dean Givens prior to the meeting and was presented to the Board. Mr. Givens updated the Board on several projects happening around the lake. There were no comments from the Board.

Report from Council Liaison:

Commissioner John Kilby stated that he did not have anything specific to report.

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Special Topics:

Discuss Dredging in Firefly Cove:

Mr. Joe Pritchett presented the dredging proposal for Firefly Cove. Mr. Pritchett explained how sediment had washed into Firefly Cove and is causing navigational problems for boaters and residents. The Board ensued in discussion regarding the Firefly Cove proposal. Board members had concerns that a lot of sediment had washed in during the recent storms and supported the idea that Council budget \$100,000 or more for additional dredging in other areas of the lake. The Town has a "list" of lake front homeowners that would like assistance from the Town to dredge their areas of the lake.

Mr. Gary Hasenfus made a motion to recommend that Council budget additional funds in the 2019-2020 budget for dredging in areas of the lake outside of the Town's normal dredging area. Mr. Bill Ashman seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

Board Member Areas of Responsibility Reports:

Mr. Givens presented a request from the Lake Lure Tours to move a 200' section of town owned dock to be located at the beach to allow for events, a non-motorized launch, and a lifeguard stand. The Board liked the proposed location but asked that Mr. Givens study the Town's need for the docks and bring the information back to the Board for review.

Mr. Givens presented a new sticker for non-motorized vessels that states the non-motorized rules for Lake Lure. This sticker will be given with all non-motorized permits and be required to be attached to the vessel. The Board stated they would like the sticker to explain the "no-wake" area and Mr. Givens stated that he would incorporate this into the sticker.

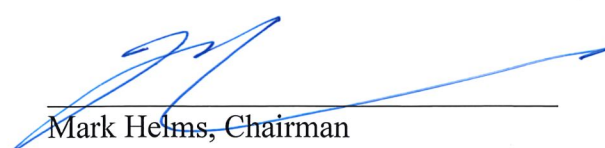
No areas of responsibility were reported.
