

Minutes of the REGULAR meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, North Carolina, October 2, 1928.

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, North Carolina, was held in the Administration Building in said Town on October, 2, 1928, the following members being present, to-wit:

L. C. Cobb, Mayor, S. V. Hooker and F. B. Logan, Commissioners. The same being the full Board.

It was moved by Mr. Logan, seconded by Mr. Hooker, that notices be mailed to all property owners in the Town of Lake Lure at once, and that the following rates of discount and penalties be adopted, and notice of same be sent to property owners:

One and one-half percent (1½%) discount in October, one percent (1%) in November, one-half percent (1-2%) in December and par in January. One-half percent (1-2%) penalty in February, one percent (1%) in March, one and one-half percent penalty in April.

On motion of Mr. Logan, seconded by Mr. Hooker, the following resolution was carried:

Be it resolved that Sara Moss be, and she is hereby appointed Tax Collector for the Town of Lake Lure for the period beginning October 1, 1928 and extending to May 31, 1929 at a salary of \$25.00 per month; that the tax books be, and they are hereby ordered to be delivered into the custody of the said Tax Collector; that bond for \$1000 as submitted by said Tax Collector be, and the same is hereby accepted and approved. Said bond being deemed sufficient and proper in surety and amount; said Tax Collector be, and she is hereby authorized and directed to at least once per month, report tax receipts and remit for same to the Town Clerk of the Town of Lake Lure, N. C.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, the following budget was adopted:

One-fourth of expenses to May 31, 1928 ----	\$500.00	
Expenses June 1, 1928 to May 31, 1929 -----	4110.00	
Int. Coupons due April 1, 1928-----	7500.00	
Int. " " Oct. 1, 1928 -----	7500.00

Misc. Audits, etc. -----	890.00	\$30,000.

Upon motion of Mr. Hooker, seconded by Mr. Logan, the following water rates were adopted:

Minimum	3,000 gal.	\$1.25
Extra	3,000 gal.	60¢ per ft.
"	4,000 " "	40¢ " "
"	5,000 " "	30¢ " "

10% discount before the 10th.

Mr. Hooker reported to this Board that the Town had on hand approximately 350 tons of 12" cast iron pipe and fittings that was not needed, and stated that in his opinion, it should be sold and replaced by smaller pipe.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, Mr. Hooker was authorized and directed to give proper notice of the sale of such pipe and fittings, and to take up the matter with all persons who might be interested in the purchase of the same to the end that the best price possible might be obtained, and to report to this Board for further action.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was duly adjourned.
