

MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE BOARD  
OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF  
LAKE LURE, SEPTEMBER 21, 1927.

At a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, North Carolina, duly and regularly called and held at the town office in Lake Lure, N. C., on the 21st day of September, 1927, there were present L. C. Cobb, Mayor and S. V. Hooker and J. B. Phillips, Aldermen, and basent, None.

The Mayor presented for the consideration of the meeting, a resolution passed by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Rutherford, which was, on motion duly made, seconded and carried, ordered to be spread upon the minutes of this meeting, which is accordingly done as follows:

" RESOLUTION "

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners for the County of Rutherford that it is to the interest of Rutherford County and the Township of Chimney Rock and its inhabitants, that the Board of Commissioners do proceed with the construction of a county highway running from a point on Buffalo Creek near the residence formerly known as the Thomas Frady residence along the north-east edge of Lake Lure to a point neat the dam impounding the waters of Broad River in Chimney Rock Township, there connecting with roadway which has heretofore been constructed by Chimney Rock Mountains, Incorporated, connecting with State Highway No. 20, a portion or all of said Highway being within the incorporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that W. G. Harris, Chairman of the Board of Commissioners for the County of Rutherford, is hereby authorized to obtain an agreement from the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure that the Board of Commissioners for the County of Rutherford shall have full charge and control of said road work herein proposed to be done by the Board of Commissioners for Rutherford County within the limits of said Town of Lake Lure."

After due consideration and discussion of the foregoing resolution, the following resolution was, on motion of S. V. Hooker, seconded by J. B. Phillips and carried by unanimous vote, adopted:

"RESOLUTION"

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for the County of Rutherford contemplate the construction of a county highway from a point on Buffalo Creek near the residence formerly known as the Thomas Frady residence and runs along the north-east edge of Lake Lure to a point near the dam impounding the waters of Broad River in Chimney Rock Township, there connecting with roadway which has heretofore been constructed by Chimney Rock Mountains, Incorporated, connecting with State Highway No. 20, a portion or all of said proposed highway being within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure and its Mayor do hereby agree that the Board

of Commissioners for the County of Rutherford may construct said road through the Town of Lake Lure and shall have full charge and control of all the work to be done upon said road within the limits of said Town.

There being no further business, the Meeting adjourned.
