

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD  
OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE.

Upon notice duly given, a special meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N. C., was held Monday, May 5, 1930. The following members being present, to-wit:

B. F. Logan and J. T. Arnett, Commissioners. Mr. Arnett acting as Chairman of the meeting.

The resignation of L. C. Cobb as Commissioner and Mayor of the Town of Lake Lure was received.

On motion duly made, seconded and carried, Mr. R. H. Long was elected Commissioner. Mr. Long was present and accepted the election as Commissioner of Public Utilities at a salary of \$50. per month beginning Feb. 1, 1930, and qualified by subscribing to the following oath:

R. H. Long, being duly sworn deposes and says; "that I will faithfully and impartially discharge the duties of Commissioner of the Town of Lake Lure to the best of my skill and ability; so help me God."

Upon motion made, seconded and carried, Mr. J. T. Arnett was elected Mayor of the Town of Lake Lure, and Mr. Long was designated as Commissioner of Public Utilities.

Upon motion made, seconded and carried, the Mayor was instructed to proceed with the foreclosure of the liens for taxes for the year 1928 as quickly as the law of the State will permit.

Upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, Mr. Luther Edwards, Attorney of Rutherfordton, N. C., was appointed as assistant Attorney. His compensation to be determined upon at a later time.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
