TOWN OF LAKE LURE.

The regular meeting of the Mayor and Town Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was held in the office of the Mayor on March 24, 1931 at 5:30 P.M., at which were present the Mayor and the entire Board of Commissioners.

It was decided by the Board that the regular biennial election for the Town of Lake Lure should be held on the first Monday in May of this year, and that a registrar and judges for said election should be appointed.

It was, therefore, upon motion of R. H. Long, which was seconded by Mrs. H. C. Keeter, unanimously ordained that L. E. Reed be appointed registrar for said election and Ernest Harris and Miss Florence A. Marsh be appointed judges for said election; said judges being of different political parties, good character and able to read and write.

It was further ordained that said election should be held in room No. 1 of the Administration Building and that the same should be held according to the provisions of law for the holding of municipal elections, and that the Mayor of the Board, to-wit: J. T. Arnett, be authorized and directed to make publication of the appointment of the said registrar and judges and of the time of the holding of said election, by posting a notice thereof at the door of the voting place where the election shall be held ^{and at three other public places} and that he shall cause a notice of their appointment to be served upon the aforesaid registrar and judges by the Sheriff of Rutherford County.

It was further ordained that the registration books shall be revised by the registrar as provided by Sections 2657, 2658, 5947, and 2659 of the Code, and other Sections of the Statute applying thereto.

It was further ordained that the judges and registrar herein appointed shall take the oath of office as provided by Section 2661 of the Code.

It is further ordained that the polls shall be open and closed and that the said election shall be conducted as provided by Sections 2664, 2665, 2666 and 2667 of the Code and other Sections of same relating thereto and the amendments to same.

Upon motion made and seconded, the meeting was adjourned.
