

At a Special Meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held on the 12th. day of April, 1932, the following business was transacted:


Mr Arnett made a report of his findings on the advisability of installing Street Lights. He reported that the Carolina Mountain Power Corporation would grant a very reasonable rate of approximately \$25.00 per year on each 200 Watt bulb. UPON MOTION AND SECOND, it was decided to erect five light standards around the Plaza and to connect the four standard already installed on the Pool Creed bridge, which would mean seven 200 Watt lights to burn about eleven hours each night.

It was brought to the attention of the Board that the War Mothers' Memorial Association wished to erect a memorial on some suitable spot on the Plaza. Permission was cheerfully granted to provide this space and for the town authorities to offer their assistance in carrying out a suitable programme.

The Mayor presented a letter of resignation from Mr. Ernest I. Harris, a former Commissioner, due to the fact that he was moving out of the corporate limits of the town. The resignation of Mr. Harris was accepted with regrets and upon motion duly made and seconded, Mr. J. A. Vess was elected town Commissioner to fill the unexpired term. Thereupon Mr Vess took the required oath of office as Commissioner.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was duly adjourned.




