

At a regular meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure held in the office of the Mayor on the 26th. day of April, 1932, at which were present the Mayor and entire Board of Commissioners, the following resolutions were duly adopted, upon motion and second, and by unanimous vote of the Board:

ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF
BOATS ON LAKE LURE .

No.1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to operate a motor boat upon Lake Lure unless the same is equipped with an effective muffler or under water exhaust. PROVIDED: That the Mayor and Secretary of said Town may upon request, when in their judgment is expedient to do so, issue permits for the operation of boats for limited periods and on special occasions, which are not equipped with mufflers as hereinbefore provided for.

No.2. It shall likewise be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate a motor boat upon Lake Lure between the hours of ten o'clock, P.M. and eight o'clock, A.M. of each day and between the hours of ten o'clock, A.M. and twelve o'clock, Noon, on Sundays, in such manner as to annoy persons engaged in religious worship, or residents of the Town in their dwellings and habitations.

No.3. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate any boat, canoe or other floating object nearer than twenty-five (25) feet of the intake which is located near the dam, or between the diving tower and the bathing beach, or within twenty-five (25) feet of said diving tower.

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of the foregoing ordinance, shall be subject to a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.) Dollars for each and every offense.


HEALTH ORDINANCE


It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation residing within that part of the Town of Lake Lure known as Luremont Section No.1 and Luremont Section No.2, to dispose of garbage in any way except by burning in an incinerator, or disposing same at regular garbage dumps designated by the Town, or in a receptacle provided for that purpose which receptacles shall likewise conform to regulations provided by the Town.

All persons, firms, or corporations residing or doing business within that part of said town known as Laurent Section No.1, and Laurent Section No.2, shall be required and are hereby required to have their residences and places of business connected with a sewer line of said town where the same is available or with an approved Septic Tank or Cess Pool where indoor toilet facilities are used, and when indoor facilities are not available they shall have a suitable and approved toilet located at a suitable place to be approved by the Commissioners of said Town, and this ordinance shall be effective on and after June 1, 1932.

Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of the foregoing ordinance, shall be subject to a fine of Twenty-Five (\$25.) Dollars. for each and every offense.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was duly adjourned.
