

At a regular meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held in the office of the Mayor on the 7th. day of June, 1932, at which was present the Mayor and entire Board of Commissioners, the following business was transacted:


Upon motion duly made and seconded, the Tax Collector was instructed and authorized to join with the county authorities in any foreclosure procedure instituted for 1929 tax delinquents appearing on the tax records of the Town of Lake Lure, if found that the county is preparing to take such action.

Upon motion made by Mr. Voss and seconded by Miss Marsh, that having duly considered the applications for policemen for the Town of Lake Lure; Mr. S. P. Smith and Mr. L. A. Harris are hereby appointed to alternate in day and night duties under schedule to be worked out and supervised by Mr. Arnett.

It is further ordered that Mr. Smith's appointment shall be effective on June 16th. and to end on August 31st. and shall be paid a salary of \$50.00 per month. And that Mr. Harris shall commence duty on July 1st. and end Sept. 15th. at a salary of \$50.00 per month.

Each appointee shall take the prescribed oath of office and furnish a bond of \$500.00 and shall be governed by regulations of the Board of Commissioners and enforce any Town Ordinance adopted.

There being no further business to come before the Board and upon motion and second, the meeting was adjourned.
