
At a regular meeting of the Mayor and Board of Commissioners held in the office of the Mayor, on Tuesday, April 3, 1934, the following business was transacted:

As a result of an appeal from the Carolina Mountain Power Corp., to the State Board of Assessment, for a reduction in valuation and the town Secretary having been handed a copy of a letter addressed to the Chairman Board of Commissioners, Rutherford County, ordering that said valuation be reduced to \$330,000. AND, WHEREAS, the County Board of Commissioners having adopted a resolution to this effect, dated April 3rd, 1934. IT IS ORDERED, after motion duly made and seconded, that the tax collector of the Town of Lake Lure, make the necessary corrections to reduce the valuation of said properties from \$500,000. to \$330,000. to be fixed until further changed according to law.

The Town Treasurer was instructed to receive bids to repair the boat house and ordered to pay from the town funds a sum not to exceed \$75.00, said amount being the like sum received for damages to said property and credited to Parks and Playgrounds account on December 22nd. 1933.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned.
