At a special meeting of the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held in the office of the Mayor on Monday, August 13, 1934, same being the second Monday in August, there were present the Mayor and the entire Board of Commissioners of said Town, the following business was transacted:

Mr. Vess introduced the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector of the Town of Lake Lure has filed with the Board, as provided by law, a report and itemized list of all uncollected taxes within said Town for the year 1933, and has made the report and recommendations as required by law with reference to the collection of said taxes; and


WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Commissioners of said Town that the Tax Collector of the Town of Lake Lure should proceed to advertise the real estate of owners delinquent in the payment of their taxes for the year 1933 within said town;


BE, IT THEREFORE, RESOLVED:

That, J. A. Riddick, Tax Collector of the Town of Lake Lure for the year 1933, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for sale for four consecutive weeks in the Rutherford County News, a newspaper published in Rutherford County, beginning with the issue of said paper published in Rutherfordton, N.C. on Thursday, August 16, 1934, all real estate within the corporate limits of said town which is liable to sale for unpaid taxes for the year 1933, which shall be sold pursuant to said advertisement between the hours of 12:00 noon, and 2:00 o'clock, p.m. on MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 1934, pursuant to Sections 1334 (48), 2969(r), 8012, 8014, 8015 and 9017, of the Code of North Carolina, and Chapter 213 of the Public Laws of 1927 and Chapter 560 of the Public Laws of 1933, and other laws amendatory of said sections and other provisions of law applicable thereto.

Adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Mr. Greig and the same unanimously adopted by the Board.

Upon motion and second, the meeting was adjourned.
