A regular meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, was held on Tuesday, August 21st. 1934, in the office of the Mayor and the following business was transacted:

Upon motion by Mr. Greig which was duly seconded, the Town Treasurer was authorized and is hereby directed to make any necessary expenditure from the Town's funds for the usual maintenance and operation of the town's affairs until such time that the budget for the 1934-35 fiscal year is presented and approved. All expenditures made from the end of the past fiscal year up to date are hereby also approved.

The following motion was made by Mr. Vess and seconded by Mr. Greig:

RESOLVED:


That J.A.Riddick, Tax Collector of the Town of Lake Lure, and M.L.Edwards, Attorney for said Town, be and they are hereby instructed and directed to proceed immediately to institute foreclosure proceedings for all uncollected taxes due the Town for which tax certificates have been issued more than eighteen (18) months prior to this date. This resolution was unanimously adopted by the Board.

Due to the fact that the Town is contemplating budgeting for the Relief of the Poor for the present fiscal year and that these funds will include an appropriation of \$75.00 for the Rutherford County National Re-Employment Service, the Town Treasurer was authorized and hereby directed to expend one-fourth of this amount in advance in compliance with the request of this agency. A motion was carried to this effect.

A motion was made by Mr. Vess and seconded by Mr. Greig that the Town Clerk, J.A.Riddick, be authorized to draw salary in advance and is hereby granted a vacation with pay.

The Mayor reported on the results of his negotiations with Mr. M.L. Edwards as attorney and for such fees for the fiscal year 1934-35. Upon motion by Mr. Greig and second by Mr. Vess the rate of pay was established at \$50.00 per month which was to cover all legal services and expenses within the county and that the cost of legal trips out of county to be in addition to this pay. The above was adopted but made subject to revision.

Upon motion and second, the meeting was adjourned.
