At a special meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners held in the office of the Mayor on Tuesday, January 15th, 1935, the following resolution was offered by Mr. Greig, and seconded by Mr. Vess, and duly adopted:

WHEREAS, the greater portion of the one mile and one-half of road leading to the properties of Dr. J. M. Washburn and others has become almost impassable for winter travel and has to be used several times daily by the property owners; and


WHEREAS, Dr. Washburn has recently made extensive improvements on his property for the accommodations of visiting clients and has paid his taxes up to date; and

WHEREAS, said road was originally hardsurfaced only part way and money derived from sale of Street Improvements Bonds was intended for the completion of this and other town roads but never finished;

BE, IT THEREFORE, RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and/or the Town Treasurer be and they are hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the improvements of this and other roads and are authorized to expend from the Special Funds derived from the final dividend in the liquidation of the Chimney Rock Trust Co., same being the proceeds from said Street Bonds and deposited in the Wachovia Bank & Trust Co., not more than \$200.00 for the purchase of crushed rock to be ~~used~~ used on aforesaid roads.

Upon motion and second, meeting was adjourned.
