A meeting of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was called by the Mayor and held as an adjourned meeting in the office of the Mayor of the Town of Lake Lure on the 15th. day of May, 1935, at which said meeting a quorum was present, and the following proceedings had:

The matter of fixing the license fees and special privileges for fishing in Lake Lure and the operation of boats upon said Lake was discussed, and upon motion of N.A. Greig, duly seconded by J.A. Vess, the Board voted unanimously to continue the charges of license fees as heretofore provided by ordinance of June 6, 1933, at the same rate for fishing and boating for another year, and the rates were so fixed and so ordered by the Board.

The question of leasing the lake for another year from the Carolina Mountain Power Corporation under the same conditions and regulations as heretofore existing was discussed by the Board, and upon motion of J. A. Vess, duly seconded by N. A. Greig, which motion was unanimously adopted, it was ordered that J. A. Riddick, Town Clerk, be authorized and directed to advise the said Carolina Mountain Power Corporation that the Town would be glad to renew its contract for the lease of the lake upon the same conditions as heretofore existing between the Town and the said Power Corporation.

There being no other business before the meeting, it was adjourned to be called at a subsequent date by the Mayor.
