An adjourned meeting of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was duly held in the office of the Mayor, at the call of the Mayor, on May 24th., 1935, at which meeting a quorum was present, and the following proceedings had:

Upon motion of J. A. Vess, Commissioner, which was duly seconded, and upon unanimous vote of the Board, it was ordered that the following schedule of fees should be adopted by the Municipal Golf Course for the year 1935:

Upon motion and second, and by unanimous vote of the Board, J. A. Riddick, Town Clerk, was directed to communicate with Mr. W. H. Lyle, golf pro., and to advise him that the Town was willing to renew its contract for the present season at the same rate as last season, provided this proposition was accepted immediately, and in the event that the said W. H. Lyle declined to renew the said contract, the said J. A. Riddick and Stanley Gresley, were appointed a committee to make arrangements with some suitable person to take charge of the club house and collect green fees upon a salary or commission basis, the expense of which should not exceed the cost and operation under the present arrangements.

Upon motion and second, the Board voted unanimously, directing Mr. J.A. Riddick, Town Clerk, to send to the Carolina Mountain Power Corporation of Philadelphia, the following telegram, to-wit:


