A special meeting of the Mayor and entire Board of Commissioners was held in the office of the mayor on July 9, 1935, at which the following business was transacted:


A contract was presented by Mr. F. P. Stratford, C.P.A. to audit the Town's books for the fiscal year 1934-35 and to assist in preparing the Town's annual budget at a salary of \$25.00 per day and mileage. Same was approved and ordered by the Board subject to the approval of the Local Government Commission.

Upon motion by N. A. Gregg and duly seconded by J.A. Vess, Town Clerk & Treas., J. A. Riddick was authorized and directed to pay the Town's operating expenses currently from the Town's Treasury from July 1, 1935 until such time as the budget for 1935-36 is adopted.

A delegation from the village of Chimney Rock/the Town Board to contribute to the month salary of a night-watchman to patrol the highway leading through both areas. The Town wishing to cooperate with Chimney Rock authorized its Treasurer to expend an amount not to exceed \$20.00 per month as police protection during the summer months for this purpose, provided such arrangements materialize.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously adopted that the annual salary of J. A. Riddick, Town Clerk, Treasurer and Tax Collector, be fixed at \$1,380.00 in addition to other fixed allowances, for the fiscal year 1935-36.

Upon motion and second, meeting was adjourned.
