A special meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was held in the office of the Mayor on Tuesday, August 27, 1935, at which the entire Board was present and the following business transacted:

WHEREAS, it was brought to the attention of the Board that the Town's present water system was becoming inadequate through the need of water pipe line extension and the deterioration of the wooden Dam and storage reservoirs, and that certain improvements were badly needed in the improvements of Parks, Playgrounds and Beach; and

WHEREAS, the town did not have sufficient funds available to make necessary improvements to said water system and parks & playgrounds, IT WAS MOVED and seconded that the Mayor and Secretary were directed to prepare an application for an estimate of Federal expenditures through the Works Progress Administration and to pledge the Town's share as sponsor of such a project.

IT WAS MOVED and seconded that the town Treasurer be authorized and he is hereby directed to expend from the town's funds not to exceed the sum of \$50.00 to defray the expenses of an Engineer to make the necessary survey and plans for such a proposal.

Upon motion and second, meeting was adjourned.
