At a regular meeting of the Mayor and entire Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held in the town office on Tuesday, February 2, 1937, the following business was transacted:

It was reported to the Board that the firm of Rickman & Pipes, lumbermen, were erecting a lumber camp a few feet downstream from the town's water intake dam and would later install a sawmill on the lands of Warner Co. of which is a part of the town's water-shed, for the purpose of logging.


The Board ordered the town Secretary to notify the county Health Department as to these activities and request them to cooperate with the town authorities in protecting its water supply. Also that they furnish to said lumbermen state regulations and instructions as governs municipal water-sheds.

The Clerk was also ordered to notify the State Forester to post regulations in said camp as to fire-fighting and prevention.

The Board ordered the town Treasurer to pay the following bill:

M. L. Edwards, Attorney- \$100.00 for extra legal services, and charge same to Contingent Legal Fees.
