At a regular meeting of the Mayor and the entire Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held in the town office on Tuesday, March 16, 1937, the following business was transacted:


Upon motion of Commissioner Greig, seconded by Commissioner Vess, J. A. Riddick, Secretary and Treasurer of said town, was directed to file with the town records a copy of the two recent Acts passed by the Legislature, the same being House bill No. 539 and House bill No. 540, one of the same providing and directing that the Town of Lake Lure accept bonds in the payment of taxes and the other authorizing and directing the County Commissioners of Rutherford County to appoint a Tax Commission for Chimney Rock Township and that said Secretary and Treasurer be directed to accept bonds in payment of taxes as provided and set forth in said bill and to accept the valuations when same are fixed by said Tax Commission as the town's valuations upon the property re-valued by said Tax Commission and to collect the town's taxes based upon said valuations as provided by said Act.

Both of said Acts hereinbefore referred to being mandatory and it being the duty of the Town to observe and follow the provisions set forth therein, the Tax collector for said town is hereby ordered to settle all tax accounts accordingly.


On motion of Commissioner J. A. Vess, seconded by Commissioner N. A. Greig and receiving unanimous vote of the council, it was ordered that the regular biennial election for the Town of Lake Lure for the year 1937 be held on Tuesday, May 4th, this being the first Tuesday after the First Monday in May, as provided by law, and that Mrs. Thelma Odom Powers be and she is hereby appointed Registrar and that Walter N. Leiter and G. W. Early be and they are hereby appointed judges for said election, and that the registration books open at the town office at 9 o'clock A. M. April 17th and close at 9 o'clock P.M. on April 24th. Said books shall be open all other days, except Sunday, from 9 A. M. until 5 P.M.

It was further ordained that said election be held in Room No. 4-Administration Building and that the same should be held according to the provisions of the law. It was further decided that those heretofore registered are not required to register again for this election.

Upon motion and second, meeting was adjourned.
