At a regular meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held on Tuesday, April 6th. 1937, the following business was transacted:

Upon motion of Commissioner Greig, seconded by Commissioner Vess, the resolution adopted at the last meeting of the Board, held on Tuesday, March 16th. 1937, directing the Secretary and Treasurer of the Town of Lake Lure to accept bonds in payment of taxes under the provisions of an Act of the recent Legislature of North Carolina, same being H.B. No.540, be and the same is hereby amended by adding at the end of said resolution, following the words "provided by said Act " the following:

Provided, that all persons, firms or corporations using the town Bonds in payment of taxes as provided by said Act be required when tendering the bonds for payment of taxes, to surrender to the town for cancellation all unpaid interest coupons, both matured and unmatured, constituting a part of said bonds; and that the amount of said coupons shall not be a part of the credit to be allowed by said ~~town~~ upon the payment of said taxes.
