At a special meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held on Tuesday, August 10, 1937, the following business was transacted:

WHEREAS, J. A. Riddick, Tax Collector of the Town of Lake Lure, has filed with the Board, as provided by law, a report and itemized list of all uncollected taxes within such town for the year 1936, and has made the report and recommendations as required by law with reference to the collection of said taxes; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Commissioners of said Town that the Tax Collector for the town should proceed to advertise the real estate of owners delinquent in the payment of their taxes for the year 1936;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that J. A. Riddick, said Tax Collector, be and he is hereby instructed and directed to proceed at once to advertise and sell on Monday, September 14, 1937, according to law, all real estate listed for taxes in the town of Lake Lure for the year 1936 of persons and corporations whose taxes are not paid on or before that date.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Mr. Vess who moved its adoption and was seconded by Mr. Greig and the same unanimously adopted by the Board.

J. A. Riddick, Treas. and Tax Collector for the Town of Lake Lure, filed a report of the special Tax Commission of Chimney Rock Township dealing with the valuation of the property of the Chimney Rock Company, which said report the Secretary was directed to copy in the minutes of this meeting:

"To the TOWN OF LAKE LURE"

Gentlemen:

You are advised that the Tax Commission appointed for Chimney Rock Township has valued the land of the Chimney Rock Company as follows: 67 acres original Freeman land, 44 acres L. Blincy purchase, 25 acres J. T. Patrick land, 36 acres J. M. Black land, 11 acres Road entrance, 41 1/2 acres Consolidated tract, 246 acres Patrick land and 1 W. H. Wheeler lot

at the sum of \$47,500.00. In accordance with the statute enacted by the last Legislature, this should be the value upon which you collect your municipal taxes for the year 1936.




