At a special meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held on Tuesday, August 9, 1938, the following business was transacted:

WHEREAS, J. A. Riddick, Tax Collector of the Town of Lake Lure, has filed with the Board, as provided by law, a report and itemized list of all uncollected taxes within such town for the year 1937, and has made the report and recommendations as required by law with reference to the collection of said taxes; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Commissioners of said Town that the Tax Collector for the town should proceed to advertise the real estate of owners delinquent in the payment of their taxes for the year 1937;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that J. A. Riddick, said Tax Collector, be and he is hereby instructed and directed to proceed at once to advertise and sell on Monday, September 12, 1938, according to law, all real estate listed for taxes in the town of Lake Lure for the year 1937 of persons and corporations whose taxes are not paid on or before that date.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Mr. Greig who moved its adoption and was seconded by Mr. Vess and the same unanimously adopted by the Board.

The Board approved the expenditure of \$20.00 to Mrs. C. H. Ward, Jr. as clerk hire in connection with preparing a tax statement for the Lureland Realty Corp. due to the fact that said corporation requested at once a statement of their tax accounts in accordance with the Bond and County revaluation plan.

Upon motion and second, meeting was adjourned.
