At a special meeting of the Mayor and the Town Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held on Tuesday, November 29, 1938, the following business was transacted:

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake Lure being a resort community, has adopted ordinances regulating the recreational facilities on the lake for the welfare and protection for the public; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Lake Lure has controlled and regulated the fishing and boating in lake Lure for the past five years through the consent of and by lease arrangements with the Carolina Mountain Power Corp., owners of such areas within the town limits; and

WHEREAS, the Town having invested considerable time and money in stocking and protecting the fish in said waters, find it necessary to designate and close certain areas to the public from time to time for purpose of spawning and growth of the fish within such areas:

BE IT THEREFOR RESOLVED:

THAT, it shall be unlawful for any person to fish or to take fish in any manner; or, to operate a boat or to engage in any boating whatsoever, in the section known as Tryon or Seaplane Bay and its coves. Said area being the south-eastwardly arm of lake Lure: Provided, that the town authorities or lake owners may have the right to issue a special permit for boats to enter this area on an occasion other than for the purpose of fishing.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that any person violating the foregoing ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$5.00, each violating being a separate offense. And that this ordinance shall take effect immediately and terminate at the withdrawal of the consent of the lake owners or the rescinding of this ordinance by the town commissioners.

IT IS ORDERED, that the town clerk cause appropriate signs and markers to be placed at the areas so designated and to have news items published giving such notice.

The foregoing resolution was read and its adopting was moved by N. A. Greig, which motion was seconded by J. A. Vess, and the same was unanimously adopted by the Board.

Upon motion and second, meeting was adjourned.
