An adjourned meeting of the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was held in the town office on Tuesday, August 6, 1942 and the following business transacted:

Upon motion of Comm. Greig which was seconded by Comm. Warner, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the town clerk has prepared and submitted to the Board of Commissioners at this meeting, a tentative budget for the fiscal year of the town beginning July 1, 1942 and ending June 30, 1943, which was duly considered and tentatively accepted by the Board;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Clerk is directed to cause a summary of said budget to be published in the next issue of the Rutherford County News, said publication to be one time only and to be in the following words and figures:
