At a special meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held on Tuesday, August 11, 1942, the following business was transacted:


WHEREAS, J. A. Riddick, Tax Collector of the Town of Lake Lure has filed with the Board, as provided by law, a report and itemized list of all uncollected taxes within said town for the year 1941, and has made the report and recommendations as required by law with reference to the collections of such taxes; and


WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of Commissioners of said Town that the Tax Collector for the town should proceed to advertise the real estate of the owners that are delinquent in the payment of their taxes for the year 1941;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that J. A. Riddick, said tax collector, be and he is hereby instructed and directed to proceed at once to advertise and sell on Monday, September 14, 1942, according to law, all real estate listed for taxes in the town of Lake Lure for the year 1941 of persons and corporations whose taxes are not paid on or before that date.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Mr. Warner who moved its adoption and was seconded by Mr. Greig and the same was unanimously adopted by the Board.
