At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, held on Tuesday, February 2nd. 1943, the following business was had:

Greig, which was duly seconded and unanimously adopted, it was decided: That due to the inactivities in the town at the present time, it was deemed necessary to relieve Mr. Dewey Price of his duties as town policeman by granting him a Leave of Absence without pay or obligation to the town, until further notice.

Upon motion and second, Mr. Cal Wilson was appointed police and warden of the town Pro Tem and the Board voted to grant a \$15.00 per month raise to Mr. Wilson in addition to his regular wages as water and street dept. foreman.

Upon motion and second, meeting was adjourned.
