At a regular meeting of the Board, held on Tuesday, July 6, 1944 the following business was transacted:

Commissioner Greig offered the following resolution and moved its adoption.

WHEREAS, the town's fiscal year ended on June 30th. and the appropriations of its various departments ends on that date; and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary for the town to continue to function in its usual way:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the towns treasurer, J. A. Riddick be authorized and he is hereby directed to make any necessary expenditure for the town's funds for the usual maintenance and operation of the town's affairs until such time that the budget for 1944-45 fiscal year be prepared and approved by the Board.

Commissioner Keeter seconded the adoption of the foregoing resolution and upon same being submitted to a vote, it was unanimously adopted.

A contract was presented to the Board by Mr. F. P. Stratford, C.P.A. to audit the Town's books for the fiscal year 1943-44 and to assist in preparing the town's annual budget for 1944-45, at a salary of \$25.00 per day plus automobile expense to and from Lake Lure.

Upon motion and second, the contract was ordered approved and signed with instructions to the clerk to forward same in triplicate to the Local Government Commission for final approval.

Upon motion and second, Mr. J. A. Riddick was appointed Tax Collector for the Town for the fiscal year 1944-45.

Upon motion and second, meeting was adjourned.
