At a Special Meeting of the Mayor and Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure on June 29, 1948, the previous minutes were read and approved.

The Clerk reported that no suitable person was found to lease the golf course and that he had employed Bill Adams, of Myrtle Beach, as temporary Pro at a salary of \$60. to \$75. per month and that he was to have full revenue from the Club house concessions and 10% of the Green fees collected for golf privileges. Upon reading the recommendation of Mr. Adams the Board authorized this arrangement for a period of four months.

The Clerk presented all unpaid bills which were examined and ordered paid.

The Board approved contract from F. P. Stratford, C.F.A. to audit the Town books for the fiscal year of 1947-48. Upon motion and second, meeting was adjourned.
