A meeting was called by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure on Tuesday, January 18, 1949, at which the following was recorded:

WHEREAS, the town has had the misfortune of losing its esteemed mayor, Dr. James Murray Washburn, who died at his home on January 16, 1949. and;


WHEREAS, it is expedient that the remaining Commissioners appoint a third Commissioners to fill the vacancy occurring on the Board in accordance with Section 3 of Chapter 179 of the Private Laws of 1927 and in further compliance with G. S. 160-10 and G. S. 160-8; and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that upon motion and second and upon unanimous vote, that Richard Washburn be, and he is hereby appointed Commissioner of the Town of Lake Lure to fill the unexpired vacancy on the town Board.

The Board adopted a Resolution of Sympathy on the death of Dr. James Murray Washburn and instructed the Clerk to express same in a letter to the family.

The Board instructed the clerk to disburse the sum of \$15.00 to the use of the Dr. Washburn Memorial Fund handled by the Church of the Transfiguration.
