A regular meeting of the Town Board of Commissioners was held on Tuesday, July 5, 1949 at which the following proceedings were held:

Upon motion and second, J.A. Riddick was reappointed Clerk, Treasurer, and Tax Collector for the Municipality.

Commissioner Allison offered the following resolution and moved its adoption.

WHEREAS, the Town's fiscal year ends on June 30th, and the appropriations for its various departments ends on that date; and

WHEREAS, IT will be necessary for the Town to continue to function in its usual way:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Town's Treasurer, J.A. Riddick, be authorized and he is hereby directed to make any necessary expenditures from the Town's funds for the usual maintenance and operation for the Town's affairs until such time that the budget for 1949-1950 fiscal year be prepared and approved by the Board.

Commissioner Washburn seconded the adoption of the foregoing resolution and upon the same being submitted to a vote, it was unanimously adopted.

It was brought to the attention of the Board that the following expenditures were immediately necessary in order to proceed with the Town's functions:


To purchase 4 Tires & tubes for the Street motor Grader at a cost of \$411.40.


To purchase a rebuilt motor for 1942 Ford truck at a cost of \$235.00.
