At a special meeting held by the Town Board of Commissioners of Lake Lure on Tuesday, January 21, 1950 the following business was transacted:


The Town Clerk reported to the Board that the County School garage was offering used International trucks for \$75.00 and that after due investigation it was his opinion that such equipment could be altered to be used on the golf course instead of a tractor.

Upon motion and second the Board moved to purchase this equipment and instructed the treasurer to have the chassis cut down and to retread the tires at a total cost not to exceed \$200.00.

The Board also voted to rescind a motion made at the meeting of December 13, 1949 in which \$1,750.00 was appropriated to buy a Farmall tractor, and instructed the treasurer to reserve these funds in anticipation of the purchase of a new truck.

Upon motion and second, the meeting was adjourned.


At a special meeting held by the Board of Commissioners of the town of Lake Lure Tuesday, February 28, 1950 the following business was transacted:

Rufus W. Nelson applied to the Board to rent the upper portion of the golf course which was not being used for the purpose of farming. He offered a rental of \$40.00 a year with an understanding that the contract would be renewed each year for five years, provided that it did not interfere in any way with the Town functions.

The Board decided to accept this offer provided a suitable cover crop was grown upon this acreage and that proper terracing was maintained to protect the drainage of the land.
