

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE, HELD IN THE TOWN OFFICE AT LAKE
LURE, NORTH CAROLINA, ON THURSDAY AFTERNOON, MARCH 20, 1952,
AT THREE O'CLOCK, P. M.

At a regular meeting of the Town Board of Lake Lure, North Carolina, held at three o'clock, P. M. on Thursday afternoon, March 20, 1952, the following were present:

Chas. R. Yopp, Clerk


After the meeting was called to order by Mayor Pearson, the following business was transacted: The contract for the year 1952 between the Town and Carolina Mountain Power Corporation was discussed. It was brought out that W. C. Allison and L. M. Pearson, Jr., Mayor, made a visit to C. W. Tillett and Wm. C. Rommel, representative of Carolina Mountain Power Corporation, in Charlotte, in order to negotiate the 1952 contract between the Town and the Power Company. The Power Company has agreed to the contract submitted to it by the Town for the year 1952. Upon motion made by C. Roy Smith that the contract as drawn be accepted and executed, which motion was duly seconded and unanimously carried, it was

RESOLVED that the Town of Lake Lure accept and execute the contract for the year 1952 between the Town and Carolina Mountain Power Corporation as drawn and read.

L. M. Pearson, Jr., Mayor, submitted a letter from Motors & Tractors, Inc., Sales Service, Spartanburg, South Carolina, offering the Town of Lake Lure (One (1) Allis Chalmers "B" Tractor, adjustable front end, for the sum of \$1525.00. Upon motion made and duly carried, it was unanimously resolved:

That the Town of Lake Lure accept the offer of Glover W. Bullman, of Motors & Tractors, Inc. of Spartanburg, S. C., for the purchase of said tractor for use by the Town of Lake Lure.
