

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE, N.C. HELD IN THE TOWN OFFICE IN  
LAKE LURE, N.C. AT 7.30 O'CLOCK P.M. TUESDAY APRIL 13, 1954

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. held in the Town Office in Lake Lure, N.C. at 7.30 o'clock P.M. Tuesday April 13, 1954, the following were present-

Visitors present were, J.C. Binder, V.T. Salter, Wm. E. Franks, and Larry Phillips.

Mr. Hamrick advised that the 29 lots sold for the Town at public auction April 5, 1954 were bid in at \$1,375.00 by Mr. F.M. Edwards. On motion of W.C. Allison, Commissioner, duly seconded by Commissioner, S.A. Eudy and unanimously passed the sale was confirmed and Mr. Hamrick was instructed to prepare the deed of conveyance.

The clerk was authorized to place an order for two (2) 100 Watt fluorescent street lamps same as the 18 installed along beach front during Feb. 1954. These 2 lamps to be installed in front of the Lake View Inn, formerly known as the administration building. Commissioner Eudy is to secure prices for a sickle bar attachment for use at Golf Course. The mayor advised that he needed his trailer which he had loaned to the Golf Club for the past 2 years without cost, He suggested that the Town might locate another for about 3 weeks when he would be glad to let the Town use again. The Town had made arrangements to secure another and Mr. Pearson was thanked for the use of his.

Mr. Hamrick is to write S.C. Arrowwood claiming \$ 250.00 for trees cut on Town's property. This is another claim and covers timber cut along where the Keller and Pearson lands adjoin Town property. A previous claim for a like amount (\$250.00) was filed against this S.C. Arrowwood for timber cut on Town's land adjacent to the Cane Creek Church lands.

A letter from the Civic Assn. of Lake Lure was read by Mr. Binder and is attached hereto. Mr. Salter advised that Mr. Rommel had agreed to maintain the water level in the lake during the summer months. It was brought up that C.H. Burgess had been permitted to cut brush along the edge of that certain farm he rents from the Town. Along with the brush will be several cords of pulp wood for which the Town is to be paid \$1.00 per cord. The matter of clearing back of the administration building was mentioned and will be attended to. Mr. Rommel is to be asked for a special monthly rate on the new lights along beach and highway. The clerk to write to Mr. Zeb Dalton forbidding the further use of the Town's Garbage dump unless the Town is paid the sum of \$8.33 monthly. Several other matters were discussed but no further action taken. No further business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
