

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE, N.C. HELD JULY 13, 1954 AT 7.30 P.M. AT THE LAKE LURE INN IN THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE, N.C.

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. held at the Lake Lure Inn in the Town of Lake Lure, N.C., Tuesday July 13, 1954 at 7.30 P.M., the following were present-

Mr. W.C. Allison, Commissioner and Mayor Pro-Tem called the meeting to order.

Mr. Hamrick reported the status of the suit against the Town on its x bonds defaulted<sup>x</sup> and advised that in his opinion the trial set for the term of Federal Court now sitting in Asheville, would probably be continued.

It was agreed that one Hubert Searcy be allowed to cut certain dead trees on the Town's property adjacent to the Town's Dump. The Town is to receive \$2.00 per cord for all the pulp wood so cut and it was made clear that no live or growing trees are to be cut but only such trees that are dead or down.

The Clerk was instructed to pay E.J. Smith & Sons Co., \$50.00 per month on the aerifier purchased for the Golf Course until the full amount of \$325.00 shall have been paid.

The Town's Treasurer was authorized to make any necessary expenditures from the Town's funds for the use, maintenance and operation of the Town's affairs until such time that the Budget for 1954-1955 fiscal year shall be prepared and approved by the Board.

Mr. J.W. Lewis was present and advised that a certain road fronting his and othera property located just back of the Grey Lodge was being opened. The Town agreed to take over and keep up after such road is completed to conform in every requirement to the State of North Carolina regulation and a legal dedication of the Road is made to the Town.

No further business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
