

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE
TOWN OF LAKE LURE, N.C. HELD IN THE TOWN OFFICE AT 7.30 P.M.
TUESDAY DEC. 14, 1954

At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. held in the Town Office at 7.30 P.M. Tuesday Dec. 14, 1954, the following were present-

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor, L.M. Pearson, Jr.

Mr. Hamrick discussed the proposition of a refunding plan to take care of all past due bonds. It was pointed out that a tax rate to care for such would more than double the present rate of 1.45. The Board members individually expressed their opinions and it was unanimously agreed that no consideration of such a refunding plan be undertaken at this time.

The matter of a flat rate on street lights was mentioned and information as to those who are paying a flat rate is to be gathered with other facts and referred to Mr. Hamrick, who will push with the Carolina Mt. Power Co., and the Utilities Commn if necessary to secure such a rate for the Town

It was agreed to discuss with Mr. Baum at the first opportunity the refunding question mentioned above, in case we later should seriously consider such a plan.

The Board decided that employees take Monday Dec. 27th as a full Holiday.

The matter of the improvement of the bathing beach was discussed at length. The Clerk was instructed to address the State C & D Dept. and secure the name of a qualified and experienced engineer to make a survey and recommendations as to how the work should be accomplished.

The matter of selling certain timber along the Golf Course lands and some of the poplars on certain Park land was brought up but not decided. It was brought out that a possible cost of \$1,000.00 would be necessary for a survey of the bathing beach and that the sale of such timber would provide that amount.

Mr. Mason Smith was to be addressed by the Clerk and requested to repair his sewer line as it enters the lake.

A general discussion by the Board and parties present was held concerning the matters above with no action taken.

Present as visitors were, Mr. Ben John Moore, Wm. E. Franks, Larry Phillips, A.C. Jaegers.

No further business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
