At a regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. held in the Town Office at 7.30 P.M. Tuesday August 9, 1955, the following were present-

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor, L.M. Pearson, Jr.

A general discussion by all Board members and Mr. Hamrick concerning the status of the suit against the Town on the outstanding bonds, was had. Also, the sewerage situation and possibility of the State Board of Health eventually taking some action in the matter.

The question of contracting the collection of garbage which was approved at the meeting of the Board July 12, 1955 page 113 this minute book, was reopened. Mr. C.H. Burgess who had agreed to accept the contract at \$2,000.00 per annum, withdrew his offer so the Board decided to continue the service as it is being done by the Town Employees until the week of Sept. 5, 1955. Then the matter will be decided as to how it will be handled.

The Clerk was instructed to get a price on 2 creosote poles and, also, information as to cost of Mercury vapor lights.

It was decided to place a light at or near Marcus Book's and another between the Dance Hall on C.R. Road and Meltons Grocery.

The Clerk was instructed to have Mr. Wilson place the two (2) poles from our stock.

No further business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
