THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS WAS SCHEDULED TO BE HELD TUESDAY NOV. 13, 1956 BUT BECAUSE THE TOWN ATTORNEY, MR. FRED HAMRICK WAS UNABLE TO BE PRESENT IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY AGREED TO POSTPONE THE MEETING TO WEDNESDAY NOV. 14th, 1956.

Commissioner Gresley was out of Town and unable to be present.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor, L.M. Pearson, Jr. Mrs. Edwards presented to the Board a proposition for printing 10,000 folders at a price of \$450.00. She, Mrs. Edwards is to prepare a proof and submit at another meeting.

Mr. Hamrick read a copy of a letter he wrote to the United States Fidelity and Guaranty Co., Baltimore, Md. asking their approval for the construction of a Town Office on certain property owned by the Town but which carries a reversionary clause in case property is used for purposes other than a park.

A general discussion entered into by all was had concerning the refunding of the outstanding bonds of the Town as well as the possible purchase of the Lake by the Town.

Mr. Hamrick advised that so far as he knew, the pending suit by Snyder and Abernathy would not be heard before the spring or early summer of 1957 (1957)

The purchase of 2 pairs of pants and 2 shirts for the police chief, A.G. Huskey, was approved.
