

Minutes of a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. held in the Town Office at 12 o'clock Noon Wednesday May 8, 1957

A report of the results of the Municipal Election held May 7, 1957 was presented by the Registrar, Mr. Clyde W. Keeter, duly signed by the Registrar and the two Judges, Wm. O. Keller and S. E. Nelon. The report showed that the votes had been duly canvassed with the following results-

For Mayor;	J. Paul Wilson	Received	78 votes

For Commissioner:	C. Roy Smith	Received	80 votes
	W. E. Franks	"	67 votes
	O. W. Moffitt	"	55 votes
	Norman Gardo Sr	"	54 votes

J. Paul Wilson having received the larger vote was declared elected as Mayor.

C. Roy Smith and W. E. Franks having received the two highest votes for Commissioners were declared elected as Commissioners.

The Mayor, Mr. J. Paul Wilson was duly sworn in by the Clerk and the Commissioners were then given the oath of office by the Mayor.

The meeting adjourned to meet at 6 P.M. Wednesday May 8, 1957 in executive session in the Town Hall.

THE BOARD MET AT 6 P.M. WEDNESDAY MAY 8, 1957 with all members present-

THE MAYOR OPENED THE MEETING. The clerk was instructed to authorize the Security Bank & Trust Co., Rutherfordton, N.C. to honor all check of the Town of Lake Lure, N.C. when signed by the clerk and either J. Paul Wilson, Mayor, or W. E. Franks or C. Roy Smith Commissioners.

On motion duly seconded and unanimously adopted, Commissioner C. Roy Smith was named Mayor Pro-Tem and Mayor, J. Paul Wilson was named purchasing agent for the Town. It was agreed that all bills be approved by the Board before payment.

Mr. Ray Vess was instructed to take over the Golf Course, hire one or two helpers if necessary and clean the course and get it in good shape as quickly as possible. Mr. Cal Wilson was given authority to hire another man to replace Mr Vess who will give his full time to the Golf Course. Green Fess of \$1.00 are to remain in effect.

A general discussion of various matters by all members of the Board was had. Particular stress was put on Keeping the Golf Course in good shape, improving the collection of garbage etc.

Mr. J. Paul Wilson, Mayor, is to locate, if possible, a place on which the Town might place a garbage dump so that there would not be so long a haul to the dump presently in use.

Mr. Manly Swaringen was named to serve as police at the Boat Dock Saturdays and Sundays at \$ 7.50 per day. The appointment is at the pleasure of the Board and not permanent.

The Clerk was authorized to have letter heads printed showing the names of the Board as now constituted with the Clerk and Treas. name omitted as the new clerk has yet to be named.

Mr. Smith suggested that letters be mailed to each of the following three- Hickory Nut Civic Club, Lake Lure Business Assn., and the N.C. Wildlife Resources Commission with a copy to Jim Connelly of the 8th District. The addresses to be furnished by Mr. Smith.

The Clerk and Treas., Chas. R. Yopp, submitted his resignation effective immediately. It was accepted but at the request of the Board he agreed to stay until July 1, 1957.

Each Board member expressed himself and pledged to work hard for the growth and development of our Town and to do all possible to make it a place where folks would enjoy being.

No further business, the meeting adjourned to meet again Tuesday May 14, 1957 at 7.30 P.M. in the Town Hall.
