

Minutes Of A CALLED Meeting Of The Board Of Commissioners Of The Town Of Lake Lure, N.C. held In The Town Office, Tuesday July 9, 1957; For The Purpose Of Reading And Approving Bills To Be Paid.

ALL Members Of Board Being Present, The Mayor Called The Meeting To Order.

The Minutes Of the Previous Meeting Were Read and Approved.

The Town Treasurer reported a Bank Balance on hand of \$ 258.96 as of June 30, 1957. All bills were read and approved. The Board also approved the current bills to be paid.

The Treasurer reported to the Board that a Check of \$2000.00 dated July 1, 1957 had been paid to the N.C. State Hgway. Commission in ACCORDANCE with a contract previously made with the Commission to hard-top one ( 1 ) mile of the road extending West from the Dam. This expenditure was ordered to be apportioned from the proceeds of the Powell Bill Funds, in accordance with the Old Board.

The Treasurer reported that Check of \$2,500.00 had been Paid to The N.C. Equipment CO. on July 1, 1957 as final payment on the Galion Motor Grader, As contracted for by the previous Board of Administration.

After due consideration, it was moved and seconded that the above obligations of the Town be included in the 1957-58 Budget due to the fact that the expenditures were made in the present fiscal year.

The Clerk presented to the Board a Tentative Budget for the Fiscal year begun July 1, 1957. The same contained an itemized account of the Receipts and Expenditures necessary to operate the Town as based upon the fiscal experience of the past three years. The 1957 Tax rate was tentatively set at 1.45 per \$100 of an assessed valuation of \$1,15000.00

The Board unanimously approved the Tentative Budget as presented in respect to the total figures of each department. the Clerk was instructed to post a copy of the Budget on the Town Bulletin Board and to Advertise same in County News Paper for one time only.

No further discussion of Town affairs, and upon a motion and second the Meeting was adjourned.
