The Mayor opened the meeting and welcomed all members and visitors.

David Lahn being a visitor, presented and discussed the Skii situation on the Lake, with the Board. It was suggested that a Skii permit be charged to all persons Skiing on the waters of Lake Lure. Season permits to concur with with boat and fishing permit dates. No action was taken on this suggestion but was tabled for further consideration.

No Skiing signs was ordered placed in Coves by the Board. These signs will be placed above the Shore line on private property. The town work crew will cut locust posts off Town property for these signs.

The Board discussed the proposition of a full time policeman for patrolling the Lake and to assist The Chief of police, Mr. Cal Wilson. Mayor Wilson suggested that the Board ask Mr. W. L. Pye to meet with them for a personal interview before January 1, 1959.

Work on the Beach House and the Beach was discussed, the Mayor said his work crew would finish a part of the work on the Beach House after the first of January, 1959.

A motion was made and carried that the Town employees be given a bonus for Christmas, the amounts to be the same as Christmas 1957. Town employees will work until noon on Christmas Eve and have time off until Monday December 29.

Mr. Smith made a motion that the Town Contribute \$10.00 to Christmas fund, for needy in the Hickory Nut Gorge area. The motion was unanimously carried. The clerk was instructed to write the check.

Monthly bills were approved to be paid.
