

The Regular Meeting Of The Board Of Commissioners of The Town Of Lake Lure Met In The Town Hall Tuesday Evening March, 14, 1961.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor.
Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

New business for discussion:
Liability Insurance for Town vehicles.

The lowest bid on fleet coverage for Town vehicles was submitted by Carter & Company of Lincolnton, N.C. A 25/50 Liability Policy for \$317.70 per year. Others submitting bids were, Chimney Rock Inc. Co. Mr. J. E. Hall, and Forest Edwards Ins. Agency, Rutherfordton, N.C.

The Clerk read a letter from C. S. Evans Marine Co. of Forest City, N.C. requesting a Complimentary boat permit for demonstrating his boats & motors on the Lake. The Clerk was instructed to mail Mr. Evans a permit, stating that these permits are to be used for demonstrations only.

The Board discussed the plans for the Biennial Election to be held May 2, in the Town Hall.

The question arose over pay for the registrar, the Law regulating the pay states that three days shall be \$15.00 per day, but is not clear as to the remaining days of registration. The Board agreed to pay the registrar \$10.00 per day for the remaining five (5) days of registration making a total of \$95.00 for the eight days registration. The Judges shall be paid \$10.00 per day.

The Clerk was instructed to post the necessary bulletins, according to State Election Laws, on the outside bulletin board and make the necessary preparations for the election. Complete plans to be included in the March minutes. Mr. Clyde W. Keeter was appointed as Registrar, Eugene Melton and Glenn Price were appointed Judges, Mr. Joe Bell was appointed as an alternate Judge.

No other business the meeting adjourned.

Town Of Lake Lure Municipal Election 1961.

Resolution:

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE CALLING A REGULAR ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND TWO MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure that, in accordance with the General Laws of the State of North Carolina, the Board of Commissioners hereby calls for an election to be held in the Town of Lake Lure on Tuesday May 2, 1961, the same being the first Tuesday after the first Monday in May, the date established by Law for said election. Said election shall be conducted for the purpose of electing a Mayor and Two Commissioners by the Voters of the Town. The Mayor and each Commissioner shall be elected to hold Office for a term of two years, and until their successors are elected and qualified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Clyde W. Keeter be and is hereby appointed as Registrar; and that Eugene Melton and Glenn Price are hereby appointed as Judges of said Election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all persons eligible to vote in the Town election, as defined by the General Law, shall be eligible to register and vote in the election herein called.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Registrar be and he is hereby directed to open the Registration Books for the purpose of recording therein the names of all eligible persons to be registered who did not register for the last preceding Municipal election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Saturday, April 22, 1961, shall be designated as Challenge Day, and that any person desiring to challenge any name included in said registration books shall on this day advise the Registrar and the Judges of this fact. The Registrar and the Judges shall thereupon set a date and a time for the hearing of the challenge, but said date shall be prior to Monday, May 1, 1961.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be published in a News Paper having general circulation in the Town or shall be posted at the Town Hall.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the final filing date for Candidates shall be APRIL 21, 1961, at 12 O'clock, Noon, Friday.
