

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING

A special meeting of the Board of Commissioners met, Wednesday May 3, 1961, at 12 O'clock, Noon, in the Town Hall.

A report of the Biennial Municipal Election held on May 2, 1961 for the election of a Mayor and Two Commissioners. The following results were given by the Registrar, Clyde W. Keeter, and were duly signed by the Registrar and the Two Judges, Eugene Melton and Glenn Price. The report showed the following count:
