
WHEREAS, it has been brought to the attention of the Town Council that the United States Post Office Department has advertised for bids for a new Post Office Building for said Town and

WHEREAS, it is the considered opinion of said Council that the general location of the present Post Office best serves the needs of the patrons of said Post Office and it would be a disadvantage if the location was moved from the Civic Center of said Town as presently Located;


Be it resolved that said Town Council go on record as favoring the present general location of said Post Office and oppose to any removal of same from its general present location in the Administration Building of the Civic Center of Lake Lure.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this Resolution be sent to the United States Post Office Department, and to The Honorable Basil L. Whitener, U.S. House of Representatives, Washington, D.C.
