

The Regular Meeting Of The Board Of Commissioners
Met In The Town Hall January 15, 1966, 7:30 P.M.

Two Members Of The Board Were Present.

The Mayor brought up to date the progress on the proposed Steam Train for the Park Area. No bids to date. Final bids to be placed with Town no later than February 17, 1966.

The Mayor and Mr. Franks discussed buying 6 new golf carts and trading the 6 old ones for 6 new ones, a total of 12 new carts for the 1966 golf season. The Mayor is to contact the EZ-Go-Car Co. for trade in value of the old carts, before a decision is made to make the trade.

The new water reservoir was discussed, new lines to be built, new customers to be added on the Boys Camp Road. These new customers have been on Mrs. John Daltons' water supply and since she can no longer supply their needs, these people have applied to the Town for water. there are 12 houses to be furnished water. The Board agreed to furnish water to these people if the water supply will reach their homes.

The Board agreed to build a Golf Cart shed at the Golf Course, materials to be used from the New Reservoir forms after the concrete is poured.

No other business the meeting adjourned.
