
The Mayor held a general discussion of Town Business, including the Golf Course, Lake and the Power Plant.

A pay raise for the work was discussed and it was unanimously agreed that Ray Vess, Hubert Searcy and Arthur Lawter be given a raise in wages of \$5.00 per week, Cal Wilson to be increased in salary to \$90.00 per week. Cal has considered retiring at the end of 1966, the Board of Commissioners has left it up to Mr. Wilson to retire or stay on the job as long as he is able to work.

Water pipe for the new reservoir was discussed and it was agreed to buy cast iron and galvanized pipe instead of the asbestos cement pipe.
