The usual business of the Town was covered by discussion, no decisions were made.


A special item of business was brought before the Board by the Mayor:

The Federal Power Commission has requested that the Town of Lake Lure make application for a Federal Permit to operate the Lake Lure Electric Power Facility. The following Resolution Authorizing the Town Attorney to obtain a Federal Power Permit was passed.

A Resolution Authorizing The Town Attorney, Hollis M. Owens, Jr. to make application to the Federal Power Commission for a Permit for the Town Of Lake Lure to operate the Lake Lure Electric Power Facility, was passed at the Regular Meeting November 8, 1966.

A Motion was made by Mayor Wilson with a second by Robert B. Jones, Commissioner, that Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Town Attorney Make Application to the Federal Power Commission for a permit for the Town Of Lake Lure to Operate The Lake Lure Electric Power Facility, which is located on the Broad River in the Western Part Of Rutherford County, North Carolina, within the Corporate Limits of The Town Of Lake Lure.

The Resolution was Unanimously passed.


