In the absence of the Mayor, Robert B. Jones, Commissioner conducted the business.


The final bill for the paving of the Bald Mountain road was approved for payment to A.R. Thompson, Contractor, Inc.

December 1, was approved as the date to lower the Lake level for winter work on boat docks and boat houses. The lake will remain at the lower level for thirty days.


The Board of Commissioners agreed to store the Patrol Boat with the Sports Center at Forest City for the winter months, fee for storage and servicing the boat, \$25.00.
