

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE
Tuesday, March 11, 1969

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on March 11, 1969. The following members of the Board were present: J. Paul Wilson, Mayor; Robert B. Jones, Commissioner; Woodrow Price, Commissioner.

Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Town Attorney, was also present.

The Mayor, J. Paul Wilson, called the meeting to order and the clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. The minutes were approved as written.

Mr. Jimmie Hall, representing the Faculty Club of Isothermal Community College was present at the meeting, and discussed with the board the matter of leasing the Penn Memorial Lodge for the use of the Isothermal College Faculty Club meetings. No decision was made on this matter.

The Municipal Election to be held for the Town of Lake Lure in May, 1969, was discussed, along with the appointment of election officials. After discussion, Commissioner Jones moved, seconded by Commissioner Price, that the following Resolution be adopted:

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A REGULAR ELECTION
FOR MAYOR AND TWO COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN
OF LAKE LURE, NORTH CAROLINA

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure, that:

1. An election is hereby called for Tuesday, May 6, 1969, the date established by law for the purpose of electing a Mayor and two Commissioners.
2. The polling place will be the Town Hall, and the polls will be open on election day from 6:30 a. m. until 6:30 p.m.
3. Clyde W. Keeter, Lake Lure, North Carolina, is hereby appointed Registrar, and Eugene Melton and Robert C. Wilson, Lake Lure, North Carolina, are hereby appointed as judges of said election.
4. The Registrar is hereby directed to open the registration books for the purpose of registering all qualified electors who request registration and who are not now registered to vote in municipal elections.
5. The registration period will be from Friday, April 18, 1969, through Friday, April 25, 1969, excluding Sunday, April 20, 1969. The registration books will be open for registration each day, excluding Sunday, during the registration period from 9:00 A. M. until 5:00 P. M. at Keeter's Esso Service, Lake Lure, North Carolina, except on Saturday, April 19, 1969, the books will be open from 9:00 A. M. until 9:00 P. M. at the polling place.

6. Challenge Day will be Saturday April 26, 1969, and challenges may be entered on such day from 9:00 A. M. until 3:00 P. M. at the polling place.

7. The Town Clerk shall, no later than Saturday, April 5, 1969, cause a copy of this resolution to be published in a Newspaper having general circulation in the Town of Lake Lure, and to be posted at the Town Hall.

FINAL FILING DATE FOR CANDIDATES SHALL BE APRIL 15, 1969
at 12:00 o'clock Noon.


