

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE
Tuesday, June 10, 1969

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on June 10, 1969. The following members of the board were present: J. Paul Wilson, Mayor; Robert B. Jones, Commissioner; and Woodrow Price, Commissioner.

Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Town Attorney, was also present.

Richard Washburn and Dr. William H. Burch, citizens of the Town of Lake Lure attended the meeting, and discussed with the Board the matter of requiring ski permits for all boat owners whose boats are used on the Lake for the pulling of water skiers and the requiring of ski permits for all individuals who water ski on Lake Lure. A tentative plan was offered, including regulations and permit prices for camps, families, non-residents and other various groups that use Lake Lure for water skiing. The Board's attention was called to the fact that water skiing is already prohibited in the coves of Lake Lure by Town ordinance. No definite decisions were made, but the board agreed to give the matter further study and to try to have a plan ready for the regulation of water skiing on Lake Lure by the 1970 season.

Provision for the payment of current bills until such time as the 1969-1970 budget is adopted was made.

Upon motion made, seconded and unanimously passed, the clerk was instructed to write off the 1958 Town of Lake Lure taxes according to the law of North Carolina.

Upon motion made, seconded and passed, the board approved the payment to W. Cecil Bolick of the sum of \$400.00 for auditing the Lake Lure Hydro-Electric Power Facility books for the year ended April 30, 1969.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:00 o'clock P. M.
