

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE
TUESDAY, MAY 12, 1970

The regular meeting of the board of commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on May 12, 1970.

The Mayor, J. Paul Wilson, called the meeting to order and the clerk read the minutes of the regular meeting held on April 14, 1970 and the minutes of the last meeting which was a special meeting held on April 28, 1970. The minutes of both these meetings were approved as written.

There was considerable discussion regarding the use of boats on Lake Lure and during said discussion, it was brought out that there are a number of camps and other commercial establishments whose properties are not located within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure and who do not pay taxes to the Town of Lake Lure who are using the lake known as Lake Lure for training and recreational purposes. It was also brought out in this discussion that many of the campers and guests of certain commercial establishments located outside the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure operate boats on the lake without having secured a permit and that these individuals upon several occasions have refused to comply with the ordinances of the Town of Lake Lure and the General Statutes of North Carolina with regard to boating and water safety generally.

After discussion, Commissioner Jones introduced the following ordinance, which was read at length:

An ordinance requiring all persons, firms or corporations to have a permit before placing, operating or allowing a boat to be operated on the waters of the lake known as Lake Lure.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure as follows:

Section 1. Except as hereinafter provided in Section 2 of this ordinance, all persons firms or corporations shall secure a permit from the Town of Lake Lure before placing, operating or allowing a boat to be placed on or operated on the waters of the lake known as Lake Lure.

Section 2. Camps, motels, hotels, inns and other commercial establishments located within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure may purchase permits for boats owned by said camps, motels, hotels and inns located within the corporate limits of the Town of Lake Lure and allow their bona fide guests to operate said boats on the waters of the Lake known as Lake Lure, and it shall not be necessary for such bona fide guests to have individual permits before operating such boats.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished in accordance with the provisions of Section 14-4 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.

After further discussion, the foregoing ordinance was adopted.

Upon motion of Commissioner Price, seconded by Commissioner Jones and unanimously adopted the board voted to give the Lake Lure Ski Club permission to tow more than two persons while practicing on May 5th and 6th, 1970, for a ski show.

The Clerk reported to the board that pursuant to a resolution adopted by the board of commissioners at a special meeting on April 6 1970, she caused the notice appended hereto, of the public hearing called for in the said resolution to be run in the Forest City Courier on April 9, 1970, and that a copy of said notice was posted on the bulletin board of the Town Hall at Lake Lure for a period of at least 7 days prior to the date set for said hearing, and that after the publication of said notice and after the posting of said notice as aforesaid, the said public hearing was held at 12:00 o'clock NOON on Friday, April 17, 1970, in the Town Hall, at Lake Lure, North Carolina, and that at said hearing certain special regulations which the board of commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure wishes the North Carolina Wildlife Resources commission to adopt for the Lake known as Lake Lure were read and discussed.

Commissioner Jones moved, seconded by Commissioner Price, that the resolution appended hereto be adopted.

The following Commissioners voting in the negative: None.


The Town Clerk and Treasurer reported to the board that at present there is a surplus of \$10,988.00 in the General Fund of the 1969-70 Budget of the Town of Lake Lure, and a surplus of \$3,809.32 in the Debt Service Fund of the 1969-70 Budget of the Town of Lake Lure; that she had been advised by the North Carolina Local Government Commission that municipalities are required to account for the disposition of all surplus funds.


